Course Hadracha is RSY-Netzer's two year leadership course. The course enables participants to develop essential leadership skills, learning how to write and run activities and manage group dynamics. Facilitated by trained professionals, educators and the most experienced bogrim (graduates) of RSY-Netzer, you will be able to develop specialist *hadracha* (leadership) skills, whilst challenging and deepening your Reform Jewish identity and literacy. Course Hadracha also provides real 'hands on' *hadracha* experience through social activism in your local synagogue. Once completed, the course will equip you with the skills needed to be involved in leadership roles in RSY-Netzer and the wider Jewish community!



What do you get out of it?

Our carefully planned programme is designed to help you build your self-confidence, focus your interests and critically think about your values. Once you have successfully completed the course, you will be well prepared to be a youth worker in Jewish communities, and may have the opportunity to work on RSY-Netzer's *Shemesh* summer camps, or another of our summer *hadracha* opportunities. The course is an excellent addition to UCAS applications and C.Vs, and can be used as part of the Skills or Community Service sections for the Duke of Edinburgh's Award.

Course structure

Course Hadracha is a two year programme. In order to pass the course you must attend the two residential events each year (a 4 night winter seminar and a weekend), and over the two years attend at least three advanced skills stream weekends (see separate sheet for details).
